

Joan and David Williams Scholarships

One Year 10 Student and One Year 12 student

Mr Kim Williams is an ex-student of Marsden High School. Mr Williams generously wants to give something back to his school by awarding scholarships to two students to assist with their education. The scholarships are named in honour of his parents, Joan and David Williams, who strongly supported the development of Marsden High School during the 1960s.

Two scholarships, worth \$2000 each, will be awarded to a Year 10 and a Year 12 student in 2019.

The criteria for selection is as follows:

- academic achievement or exceptional achievement in a subject (attach last 2 reports)
- educational disadvantage, either financial or social
- commitment to further study
- Australian or New Zealand citizen, permanent resident of Australia or holder of an Australian permanent resident humanitarian visa.

Where appropriate, supporting documentation should be provided (see application).

The selection panel will include:

Principal Relevant Deputy Principal Relevant Year Adviser P&C President or delegate

The scholarship monies will be placed in a trust fund and expenditure will be managed, monitored and approved by the Principal or delegate. It is envisaged that each scholarship will be used to expand opportunities for the student to further develop academically and/or socially in order to reach future goals and continual enrolment at Marsden High School.

Items that the scholarship monies could be spent on include: a computer, software, excursions, camps, books, tutoring or other resources to assist with learning. Please note that the funds are not intended to be used for uniforms or stationery.

The Principal may terminate the scholarship at any time at his discretion. If the student leaves Marsden High School during the scholarship year, scholarship monies may be required to be reimbursed.

A progress report is to be provided quarterly to the donor, Mr Kim Williams.
