

John Tuckerman Scholarships

Mr John Tuckerman was a student of Marsden High School (1960-1964) and school captain in 1964. In 1959 as a student of Ermington Public School he was awarded a NSW State Government means-tested bursary, which paid him a small allowance each year at high school. With this allowance, he purchased resources (e.g. technical drawing instruments) which he could not otherwise afford and thereby enhanced his learning experience. He was a dedicated student and also a keen cricketer and athlete. John came from a family that was financially challenged and is now a successful stockbroker. Motivated by the significance of the 1959 bursary and his enhanced education opportunities, he has chosen to give something back to his school and its students by sponsoring scholarships.

- A 3-year scholarship, worth \$500 per year, will be awarded to two Year 8 students in 2019. It is envisaged this scholarship will follow the student into Year 9 and Year 10.
- A 2-year scholarship, worth \$1000 per year, will be awarded to two Year 11 students in 2019.

At the end of each year, the scholarship will be reviewed in terms of the satisfactory progress and behaviour of the student and continued enrolment at Marsden High School. If the student leaves Marsden High School during the scholarship years, scholarship monies may be required to be reimbursed. A progress report is to be provided quarterly to the donor, Mr John Tuckerman.

The selection panel will be:

- Principal or delegate
- Relevant Deputy Principal
- Year Adviser
- P&C President or delegate

The scholarship monies will be placed in a trust fund and expenditure will be managed, monitored and approved by the Principal or delegate. It is envisaged the scholarship will be used to enhance learning and achievement and expand opportunities for the student to engage in new experiences to further develop academically and socially and reach future goals.

Where appropriate, supporting documentation can be attached and other people must sign, print name and date when writing supporting statements. The application must be signed and dated by the student and parent/guardian.

The criteria for selection are:

- academic achievement (reports must be attached)
- any special talents a student has in particular areas of study/achievement
- examples of good character and personal attributes including trustworthiness, reliability etc.
- evidence of participation in extra-curricular activity and school service

Any students who may be successful in being granted these scholarships are encouraged to consider the following:-

"If I am successful in life, I would like to return to the school something of my success"
