Marsden High School Prefecture Leadership Team Expectations

 \cdot Abide by the Prefecture Leadership Team's expectations. Be polite, respectful and fair. Show leadership.

 \cdot Wear Prefecture badge with pride. Uphold School expectations and values. Lead by example.

 \cdot Attend weekly Student Leadership meetings (1 lunch per week) with the School Principal and/or Deputies and SRC coordinators. Discuss relevant school issues, events and make decisions where necessary. Take turns to chair the meeting and contribute relevant updates for specific role area.

· Participate in school events and assist as requested/required.

· Liaise with your SRC crew through appropriate forms of communication.

 \cdot Be visible at School Assemblies, assist in their organisation and make announcements to students regarding relevant school information and/or events that are coming up.

· Update School newsletter with Prefecture Leadership Team news. Support each other in completing roles. Aim for cooperation not competition.

Voting Process:

- Year 11 students will be presented with this Leadership structure and expectations.
- Students applying for Prefecture (Captains/ prefects) will submit a Leadership CV of no more than 150 words to SRC coordinators, outlining their passions, interests, areas of expertise and leadership experience. Due by Thurs 3RD August, Week 3.
- All applications will be vetted by the school executive staff, including Principal and Deputies during Week 4.
- Students who are deemed suitable will have their Leadership CV information made into a booklet to be used for voting purposes.
- Students will present two speeches in Week 5 on Monday 14th August to the Yr 11 cohort and on Tuesday 15th August to the staff (from 2.30). Each speech should be approximately 3 minutes.
- From the speech presentations, Year 10, 11 and staff will vote for whom they wish to be in the Leadership Team. N.B. They will not be voting on specific roles but on you as showing potential for leadership.

- Those applying for prefecture will need to indicate for which positions they are applying. Voting will then be collated and allocated according to the positions for which each student has applied.
- Positions will then be allocated based on leadership experience, expertise, passions, speech and presentation skills, votes (and then interview if necessary).
- Students applying for prefecture will be informed of their inclusion in the Leadership Team by the Principal by Week 6 of Term 3.
- Once the leadership team has been chosen, prefects will then be asked to identify leadership opportunities within the school which would be of interest to them.
- Positions within the Prefecture Leadership Team will be announced in a whole school assembly.
- Prefecture roles will run from late Term 3, 2017 through to mid Term 3, 2018, in order to allow for a balance with HSC demands.
